a. Event planning for 2025

Colour run update

Event will be held on Thursday 21 November at 12:30 at James Meehan reserve. A big thankyou to the 24 parents that have volunteered for the event. Currently we have net profit of \$4392 as at 10 am today (13 November). The P&F executives have been in discussion with Natalie to purchase the following items:
